

Alexandru Polgár (b. 1976) has studied philosophy in Cluj, Romania. He is an editor of IDEA arts + society (www.idea.ro/revista), a journal dedicated to contemporary arts, critical theory and politics. In his work as an author, he focuses on the onto-historical elucidation of the capitalist condition in essays such as “Liberal-social-fascism (?)” (2003); “Existence Inside a Tank” (2006); “The Communist Remainder” (2008); “1989” (2012). In 2009, he co-edited with Adrian T. Sîrbu the *Genealogies of Communism* (Idea Design & Print, Cluj) and in 2013 he published a book on Gérard Granel’s thought: *Diferența dintre conceptul de piață al lui Heidegger și cel al lui Granel* (The Difference between Heidegger’s Concept of Market and that of Granel) (Idea Design & Print, Cluj).
